Radioactive materials are regularly shipped between these sites.

Each stage of the nuclear fuel chain has its own enormous radioactive waste problem.

In addition, routine emissions of radioactivity from these sites add to the degradation of the world's largest surface freshwater ecosystem.

A major accident at any one facility could have a devastating impact on the entire Great Lakes. Even if a catastrophic accident is avoided, these nuclear hot spots will have to be isolated and monitored for many generations to come.

High level radioactive waste is being stored at each reactor site in water filled pools & dry cask storage. The waste is hazardous and deadly for thousands of centuries.





The Golden Rule anti-nuclear sailboat arrived on the Great Lakes July 17, 2023 at Oswego, NY, kicking off a series of local events to raise awareness about the growing danger of nuclear war and to build support for the abolition of nuclear weapons & nuclear power.

The 34-foot wooden ketch is sailing on a 13-month voyage around the "Great Loop" of the central, southern and eastern US, as well as stops in Ontario, Canada, making 100 ports-of-call. The Golden Rule is a national project of Veterans For Peace, which owns the boat. The Golden Rule is excited to add this chapter in the epic mission for world peace.
